Dear Parents,

We are all really excited about the forthcoming school dance concert. This is a wonderful opportunity for all our students to showcase their dance talent and performance skills. With only one week away we wanted to confirm some of the details regarding the dance concert.

Attendance at the Dance Concert

Please ensure you have returned the green note to school indicating your child's participation in their class item on Wednesday and Thursday night dance concerts. This is really important as it affects the organisation of each class's dance item so we would really like all children at both performances.

Arrival and departure on Concert Nights

Children are required to be at school at 6.15 pm on the night of both dance concerts. They are to go to their allocated classroom where a teacher will supervise them for the duration of the concert.

LIBRARY

They will need to stay with their class group till the end of the concert. Parents are then asked to pick up and sign out their children after the concert is finished.

Where parents are sharing the pick-up of their children and taking home another child other than their own, a permission note from the child's parent is required.

Dance Costumes

The children are asked to bring to school on Monday a plastic bag with their name clearly marked on the bag.

On Wednesday children will need to bring their required dance costume items from home for our daytime dance concert rehearsal.

After our school dress rehearsal, the children will be given their other dance costume items to take home in their marked plastic bag. (where necessary)

Children are then required to come to Wednesday and Thursday nights' dance concerts fully dressed and ready to perform. Where the children are required to dance bare-foot, they are asked to wear thongs so they can walk safely around the school on the night. Children are able to wear light makeup -some light foundation, blush and lip gloss if required.

School costume items must then be returned to school on the Friday in the plastic bags. **Please do not wash the school costumes.**

If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.
